PSHCE

Support offered for schools to enable pupils to have the knowledge, skills and understanding they need to live confident, healthy lives as informed, active and responsible citizens.

Healthy School Programme

- ◆ Nationally accredited programme
- ◆ Healthy School Award scheme to acknowledge achievement in schools with a focus on nine themes of PSHE, Citizenship, Sex and Relationship Education, Drug, Alcohol and Tobacco Education, Physical Activity, Safety, Emotional Health and Well-being, Involving the Whole School Community and Healthy Eating. The tenth theme is an opportunity for schools to prioritise an issue for themselves.
- ◆ Support for schools applying for Award and a termly celebration event to share good practice.
- ◆ A wide range of in-service training opportunities offered for staff, Governors and parents.

Citizenship

SLA available for schools to buy-in support for the delivery and monitoring of Citizenship. Elements include Active and Global Citizenship.

Drug, Alcohol and Tobacco Education

- ◆ Support for the development of the Policy and programme of study.
- ◆ The North Tyneside Drug Education Team, offer schools support covering, for example, curriculum, policy development, parents evenings.

Behaviour Management

- ◆ Individual support, in-service training for schools and advice on strategies such as anti-bullying, social isolation and addressing behaviour management issues.
- ◆ Circle Work, Emotional Intelligence, Peer Mentoring, training and development.

Teenage Pregnancy

- ◆ Re-integration to education and ongoing support of pregnant schoolgirls and young mothers.
- ◆ Overcoming barriers to learning through alternatives to mainstream education including post-16.
- ◆ Establishing referral procedures and partnerships with schools, colleges and other agencies.

Healthy Eating and Nutrition

- ◆ Support for schools in delivering healthy eating messages via in-service training, in class sessions and resource production.
- ◆ Promote the whole-school approach to nutrition with an emphasis on water is cool, milk promotion, healthy tuckshops and 5-a-day.
- ◆ Ensure North Tyneside school meals; menu and catering practice adheres to national and local healthy eating guidelines.

PSHCE Network / Behaviour Management Strategy Network

- ◆ Termly Network meetings to support teachers on current issues, new initiatives and to support behaviour management in schools.
- ◆ Opportunities to share good practice.
